A local law to regulate where snowmobile trailers may park for free and

1. Statement of Authority. The Town Board of the Town of Florence pursuant to the authority granted under Article 4 of the Town Law, the Vehicle and Traffic Law and Sections 10 and 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York hereby adopts as follows:

2. Statement of Purpose and Findings. The Town Board of the Town of Florence finds that residents of the Town and other visitors during the winter have a difficult time finding parking for snowmobile trailers. The haphazard parking of these trailers has created difficulties in maintaining proper road access. It is the purpose of this local law to regulate where such trailers may park to provide for free and ready access to all roads by those using the Town highways.

3. Enactment. The Town Board of the Town of Florence hereby declares that there be no parking from November 1st to April 1st on each of the following roads:

- a. Hanifin Road - East side
- b. Walasek/Mulcoy Road - East Side
- c. Houlihan Road - South Side
- d. Shultz Road - North Side

Except as specifically modified herein, all other provisions of Local Law #2 of 1996 shall remain in full force and effect.

Article 4. - Severability. If any part of this Chapter shall be found to be void, voidable, or unenforceable for any reason whatsoever, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any remaining section or provision of this Chapter.

Article 5. - Effective Date. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

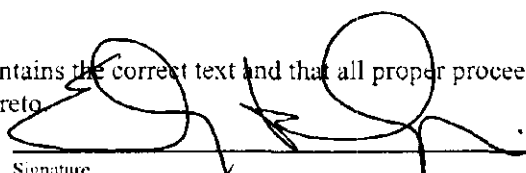
