SECTION 1: Title

This Local Law shall be known as the Local Law switching to a single appointed assessor.

SECTION 2: Purpose and Provisions

This Local Law in the Town of Florence provides that from and after April 29, 1988, there shall be but one assessor, to be appointed by the Town Board. This Local Law is being enacted pursuant to Section 328 of the Real Property Tax Law. This Local Law shall be subject to a permissive referendum. An appointed assessor appointed pursuant to this law shall meet the training requirements specified under Section 310 of the Real Property Tax Law.

SECTION 3: Effective Date

Upon expiration of the forty-five (45) days after the adoption of this law and upon filing of this law with the Secretary of State, the term or terms of office of all assessors then in office shall terminate on the date set forth in Section 2 for the establishment of the office of an appointed assessor.
