1. Statement of Authority. The Town Board of the Town of Florence pursuant to the authority granted under Article 4 of the Town Law, the Vehicle and Traffic Law and Sections 10 and 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York hereby adopts as follows:

2. Statement of Purpose and Findings. The Town Board of the Town of Florence has previously adopted a local law to establish Mulvaney Road as a low volume road scheduled for minimum maintenance. It is the purpose of this local law to repeal the designation of minimum maintenance with respect to the four tenths (4/10) of one mile of Mulvaney Road from the intersection of Hayes Road.

3. Enactment. The Town Board of the Town of Florence hereby amends its low volume road/minimum maintenance road law as follows:

Mulvaney Road – discontinue the designation of minimum maintenance for four tenths (4/10) of a mile from the intersection of Hayes Road.

Article 4. - Severability. If any part of this Chapter shall be found to be void, voidable, or unenforceable for any reason whatsoever, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any remaining section or provision of this Chapter.

Article 5. - Effective Date. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
